CHILDHOOD IMMUNISATIONS

MP Alex Mayer visited Kingsbury Court Surgery to meet the team helping improve childhood vaccination rates and protect the town's youngest residents.

Vaccination uptake among under-5s at the Church Street surgery has risen from 79% to 88% in just one year. Trident Primary Care Network (PCN), which includes Kingsbury Court Surgery, Kirby Road Surgery and Eastgate Surgery, now delivers around 138 childhood vaccinations each month, including protection against meningitis B, chickenpox, measles, mumps and rubella, as well as other routine childhood immunisations.

Alex Mayer MP said: "Vaccinations are safe and save lives. The return of diseases like measles means more children are ending up in hospital, but this is entirely preventable."

Protect your child with routine vaccinations. Immunisations are safe, effective and provide the best defence against serious diseases. Side effects are usually mild and temporary, while staying up to date with vaccinations also helps protect babies, older people and those with weakened immune systems. Keeping to the recommended schedule helps keep your family and community safe.
